

Future Leaders Fellowship Round 8: Work Plan Guidance

The work plan is a document used to visualise the project by representing timelines and milestones. Use of a PERT or Gantt chart focusing on the visual diagram with minimal text is recommended.

Please include the full duration of the 4 year fellowship (pro rata for part-time applicants). Project-specific timelines and milestones should be clearly and accurately shown. It is expected that the work plan includes a comprehensive plan for the start of the project, although later milestones can be indicative. [Note: a more comprehensive work plan covering the 4+3 full project duration will be required for submission to UKRI.]

This should be a standalone document and cannot be used to extend the case for support.

Maximum 1 page A4, must be minimum 11-point typeface, 2cm margins, either landscape or portrait layout.
